

Robinson Ranch Neighborhood Watch Tips – Group Strategy

The Robinson Ranch Neighborhood watch groups are neighborhood residents who watch out for criminal and suspicious behavior. Members will report criminal and suspicious behavior to local law enforcement help prevent crime and promote cooperation among residents and police.

Community Problems to address in the groups:

- Every day, neighborhoods across the United States confront any number of property and violent crimes and threats of crime.
- Our strategy is to provide local law enforcement with additional eyes and ears to watch out for all types of criminal activity and promote neighborhood security.
- Community crime watches can address all types of crime, but their primary focus is typically residential burglary and other crimes around the home, such as larceny and vandalism.

Key Group Components:

- The Robinson Ranch has Neighborhood been sectioned into 5 watch group areas.
- Block/Street Captains assigned to serve as points of contact for each area and/or street.
- WhatsApp Groups organized as communication network to pass along information about crime and security to residents.
- Training on recognizing and reporting suspicious activity and on home and neighborhood security.
- Provide a variety of safety and security information to residents.

Items to share in the WhatsApp Group:

- Incidents, events, individuals or circumstances you observe that seem out of place. Include the location and time observed.
- Security tips.
- Suspicious Activity.
